## PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Cathy Thacker, NCTM

I represented Georgia MTA at the MTNA Conference in Atlanta, Georgia, in March, 2024. It was wonderful to have so many GMTA members in attendance! Every Master Class performer was the student of a GMTA teacher, and the performances were exceptional. The next MTNA conference will be held in Minneapolis, Minnesota, on March 15-19, 2025.

Our GMTA membership is currently at 537 members, with 77 nationally certified teachers, and 40 collegiate members. 25 of these are new members, including 8 collegiate members and three transfers from other state associations. Please be sure to welcome new members to our conference. We have eight collegiate chapters and seventeen local associations. Georgia boasts the highest number of collegiate chapters in the Southern Division.

GMTA State Auditions were held at Piedmont University on April 6-7. We had 383 students represented by 145 teachers in this event. The GATE Theory Exam is required for all pre-college piano entrants, and students must be registered by the deadline of January 15, 2025. For the 2025 Auditions, passing the GATE will not be required to proceed to the next level.

On October 25-26, the first round of the 2024-254 MTNA Competitions were held at Piedmont University. We had 79 students and 25 teachers participating in this event. Several of the winners performed yesterday at the MTNA Competitions Recital. All winners are listed on the GMTA website. Congratulations to both students and teachers!

Our 2024-25 Georgia Local Association is Savannah MTA. Our 2024-25 Collegiate Chapter is TONIC, from the University of Georgia. Congratulations to both chapters!
